6. Realistic Eyeball: Try to realistically draw a close up of an eyeball capturing all of the patterns of color and reflections that you see.



9. Instagram Worthy: Choose a subject matter of your choice and frame it within a circle for the perfect Instagram shot.




10. Split Apart: Show something split open and fill it with interesting material.

12. Stacked Dream Dessert: Using colored pencils, draw a stack of your favorite things: the sky is the limit!




13. Pixelated: Pixelate part of your drawing to make an interesting design using colors found in your drawing.



14. Collage with Mixed Media: Collage part of your work and work back into it with other materials.




15. All About Me: Spend a page writing/ drawing things that describe you.
